WHAT WE DO

Brazoria County Association for Citizens with Handicaps (BACH) is a non-profit charitable organization which provides quality outpatient training, therapy, and guidance for families of children with physical, developmental, speech or language delays or disabilities. BACH serves residents of Brazoria County regardless of sex, race, disabling condition, creed, or nation of origin.

LOCATIONS

BACH's main facility is in Angleton. However, children are seen in their natural environment whenever possible, all over Brazoria County.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Services are provided to families in BACH's Early Childhood Intervention Program on a sliding scale basis. BACH receives support from a grant provided by the Department of Assistive and Rehabilitative Services (DARS), Division of Early Childhood Intervention; individual, church and civic organization donations; specialized corporate, private or public grants; insurance (when available) and sliding scale client fees. The United Way of Brazoria County provides approximately 3% of BACH's ECI Program budget. Our volunteers also assist with special events each year to raise local funds to support our programs.

Early Childhood Intervention Program (ECI)

BACH's ECI program treats infants from birth to three years of age who have delays in at least one developmental area: gross motor, fine motor, self-help, cognitive, language or social-emotional skills. Licensed professionals and qualified support staff provide quality therapy as well as training to parents so that they may follow through on their child's individualized program.

BACH SUPPORT SERVICE PROGRAMS

Free recreational, educational & support activities, specialized equipment, and parent support groups are also available to children with special needs (ages birth to 12-years-old) and their families.

FORM A TEAM

- Form a team in your company, neighborhood, with a group of friends or family, or just walk by yourself.
- Become familiar with BACH and the Roll 'n Stroll from the information included in this brochure. Share this information with your teammates and potential donors.
- Distribute white pledge envelopes to everyone on your team.
- Ask co-workers, neighbors, family, etc. to donate to this worthy cause.
- Be sure to include names, addresses, phone numbers and dollar amounts on your pledge envelopes so BACH can verify donations.
- Collect donations prior to the event and put them into your envelope. Money is to be collected prior to the event. Credit will only be given for money actually turned in before the event or on the day of the event.
- Notice on the envelope that incremental dollar amounts raised will earn prizes!
- Turn envelopes and all donations in to your team leader by Wednesday at noon on February 29th to be eligible for Top \$ Team.
- Come out on March 3rd to **Roll 'N Stroll** inside the Brazos Mall. Meet in the JC Penney Courtyard. Feel free to dress crazy, carry signs or banners, advertise for your company or cause.

IF YOU ARE A TEAM LEADER

Stay in contact with your team members, hype them up, encourage them to collect as much money for BACH as they can. Perhaps you'd like to incorporate some friendly competition for those who raise the most money (maybe they could be pulled in a wagon or pushed in a wheelbarrow by the rest of the team through the mall on event day!) or participate in the most spirited team contest.

Deadline for team players to turn in completed envelopes and money to their team leader is Wednesday, February 29th, by Noon.

TEAM HINTS

Ask your company to play an active role by endorsing employees fund raising efforts. Ask them to recognize team members for their community service by:

- Providing company t-shirts or caps to wear at the event.
- Putting a picture of the team in the company newsletter and local newspaper.
- Taking the team or individual who raises the most money to lunch.
- Starting off pledge envelopes with an initial donation from the company (\$5, \$10, \$15...)
- Matching the amount your employees raise to DOUBLE their earnings for BACH!
- Offering a % match.
